DAILY SCRIPTURE READINGS

When we look through the scriptures, we realize how much God desires a FRESH start for all of us. Over and over again, God: refreshes, renews, heals, blesses, makes whole, cleanses what is dingy, clears up what is blurry, resurrects what has died and recovers what is lost.

Read each passage slowly: What do you notice? What word or phrase captures your attention? What is God saying to you? Talk to God about it.

- Is 42:5-9** *Fresh things I now announce...*
- Is 43:16-21** *No need to recall the past... See, I am doing a new thing.*
- Is 48:6-16** *Now I am revealing new things to you... created just now, this moment.*
- Is 55:10-13** The freshness of rain and snow on the earth is compared to the new life of God's creation.
- Is 65:16-25** *...for past troubles will be forgotten and hidden from my eyes.*
- Lam 3:19-24** *The favors of God are not all past... every morning they are renewed.*
- Sir 43:13-33** *He sprinkles snow like birds alighting. ... The eye marvels at the beauty of its whiteness.*
- Ez 36:15-28** *I will cleanse you with clean water... I will put my spirit in you.*
- Is 1:16-18** *Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be white as snow.*
- Ps 4** *You have given more joy to my heart than others ever knew.*
- Ps 33** *God, let your love rest on us as our hope.*
- Ps 46** *There is a river whose streams refresh the city of God.*
- Ps 51** *Put into me a new and constant spirit.*
- Ps 94** *In the midst of all my troubles you console me and make me happy.*

- Ps 104** *You give breath, fresh life begins, you keep renewing the world.*
- Ps 118** *The LORD is God; he smiles on us.*
- Ps 121** *The LORD God guards you when you are leaving and coming home.*
- Ps 136** *His Love is everlasting.*
- Ps 145** *Patiently all creatures look to you to feed them throughout the year.*
- Mk 2:1-12** Jesus gives a new beginning to the paralytic.
- Mk 6:30-44** Jesus saw that the people needed new energy.
- Mk 7:31-37** Jesus opens up a fresh new world of sounds to man who was deaf.
- Mk 9:2-8** Seeing Jesus in a surprising, new way.
- Jn 4:43-54** The deep faith and new life Jesus promises.
- Jn 5:19-30** Jesus speaks of the freshness of the Father who is the "source of life."
- Jn 6:53-58** Jesus tells us that we will have new life if we believe and partake in the Bread Of Life.
- Jn 17:21-26** Jesus asks his Father to refresh us with God's Love
- Heb 8:8-12** *The days are coming when I will establish a new covenant...*
- Rev 21:1-8** *Now I am making the whole creation new.*

QUESTIONS FOR JOURNALING
