1 Corinthians 15:26 *The last enemy to be destroyed is death.*

Romans 6:9 *For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him.*

Matthew 21:14 *The blind and the lame came to him at the temple, and he healed them.*
