THOUGHT PROVOKING QUESTIONS:

- 1. What, in your understanding, distinguishes spiritual vitality from religious activity?
- 2. Reflect on the idea that spiritual vitality is often confused with fear-based thoughts related to doctrines, church attendance, and financial giving. How has this perception influenced your spiritual journey?
- 3. In 1 John 4:7-12, the emphasis is on love as the ultimate measure of spiritual vitality. How does divine love, as demonstrated by God sending his Son, address the lie of separation and spiritual emptiness?
- 4. According to 1 John 4:16b-19, perfect love casts out fear. How can we practically cultivate and express this perfect love in our relationships and daily interactions?
- 5. Discuss the idea that spiritual vitality is the confidence to love others the way God loves us. In what ways does this perspective reshape the understanding of spiritual health?
- 6. Consider the idea of being a transformed nonconformist, as mentioned in connection with Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.'s teachings. How can Christians avoid conforming to time-bound customs and earth-bound ideas while remaining engaged in the world?
